I agree to the following terms and conditions:

1. If successful in a Regional Law Competition, I will attend the Australasian Law Students' Association ('ALSA') Competitions Championships (held in Australia in early July), and the NZLSA National Law Students' Competitions Championships (held in late August/early September). The cost of attending these championships is met by the sponsoring law firms, apart from incidental costs such as meals and taxis.
2. If successful in a Regional Law Competition, I will attend both the ALSA and NZLSA Championships for this particular competition, not a different or subsequent LSS competition in which I may also be successful.
3. The first Regional Law Competition which I win shall be the competition for which I attend both ALSA and NZLSA. If a student who has won a competition enters and wins a subsequent competition, the second or next placed team will attend ALSA and NZLSA for the latter competition. LSS and Faculties will decide the composition of the teams.
4. If our team wins a competition and one of the team members is unavailable or ineligible for either the ALSA Conference or the NZLSA Conference, the second or next placed team in the competition will attend both the ALSA and NZLSA Conference in our place.
5. I agree to the release of my personal information contained in this form to both the New Zealand Law Students' Association and also to the sponsoring law firm of my particular competition and any sponsor of the NZLSA National Law Student Competition Championships. I understand that the NZLSA and any sponsoring firm may contact me using the details I have provided. I understand that this information is held in accordance with the Privacy Act 1993 and that I have the right to request a copy of the personal information held about me and to have any inaccuracies corrected.
6. I agree to abide by the rules promulgated by the sponsoring law firm for this particular LSS competition, and also by the NZLSA National Law Students' Competitions Championships Rules (ratified 27 April 2007).
7. Clauses 1 to 4 do not apply for those entering in Russell McVeagh Client Interviewing at Waikato Law School, Buddle Findlay Negotiation at Waikato Law School, and Bell Gully Mooting at Auckland Law School.
8. Where competitors are individually ranked in the Bell Gully Mooting competition, this ranking determines the winning team for the purposes of attending the ALSA and NZLSA Conferences.
